PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The project aims to provide a conceptual description of the Medical Treatment Facility ROLE 2F, being the smallest medical treatment facility that allows the provision of damage control resuscitation and damage control surgery.

Through the definition of the treatment capacity and the different deployment modalities, the aim is to establish the technical requirements of the material, the training and education needs for the personnel, and the necessary support needed once deployed, both in terms of evacuation means and the continued support of this type of capacity with very high mobility and low logistical footprint.


All of these refer to the contribution of ROLE 2F to medical support to the RDC in the different scenarios identified in the Strategic Compass.
